- Question regarding Students with Disabilities moved to here from Spring Supplemental
- New postbaccalaureate degree classifications required

COMPLETIONS (CO)

- CIP 2010 degree classifications not required until 2010-11 for 2009-10 degrees
- Degrees that are included in IPEDS are those that are awarded for the academic year (summer, fall and spring) within those terms or the following summer. For IPEDS reporting in 2008, we allowed early reporting of degrees awarded out of term for inclusion. IPEDS Completions due 10/14/09 but Summer SIFD not due until 10/23...what to do?

HUMAN RESOURCE (HR)

- New changes but note that there has been a race/ethnicity unknown category since at least the 2005-06 collection. Do we still want to require race/ethnicity for personnel submissions?

FALL ENROLLMENT (FE)

- Revise collection of student-to-faculty ratio (Part F)

 - Provide a worksheet to assist institutions with reporting
- New postbaccalaureate degree classifications required
- Currently new students are determined by using the admissions file. If students are admitted (Final Admission Action = A,P,X) then they are new. Should the method be changed to look at Type and Date at Most Recent Admission or Type and Date at Original Admission off the student file. First Professional students are set with the First Year, First Professional Flag.
- Part D: Total Entering Class – how is this calculated and can we get the information from our enrollment records?
- Part E: We will upload using GRS cohort from Fall Final

GRADUATION RATE SURVEY (GRS)

- IPEDS has requested that we include AA degree counts for those students in the cohort that have not yet earned a bachelor's or higher degree. Next year we will include that information for the Fall 2003 cohort AND we will open up the prior year survey to add it to the Fall 2002 cohort.
- Now that athletic information is not required, we will upload the GRS survey for all institutions.

GRADUATION RATES 200 (GR200) – New and permanent

- Report on 8 year completers – was reported in Spring Supplemental last year
- Separate survey from GRS so as not to confuse the two different cohorts

FINANCIAL AID - continued

- Template released for review for the Annual Financial Aid Reporting.
- Splitting awards by funding source
 - Question: Why isn't source_funds part of the unique key.
 - Funding - First Gen Program: The student financial aid file considers this program to be a state program because of the state match but we not only match the state share but grossly overmatch it. Next year we're expecting a \$8 million+ first gen program but if the state match is consistent with previous years, our state allocation will only be about \$1 million of that (plus whatever we can pick up from schools who don't use theirs). I want to be sure that however we track all this, that UF gets credit for all the private and institutional dollars in the program. But the student financial aid file doesn't allow for multiple source of aid codes.

FROM THE BOARD OF GOVERNOR'S AGENDA

The BOG must submit an annual report by January 1 of each year describing implementation of the tuition differential and include the following information:

- The course or courses for which the tuition differential was assessed and the amount assessed
- The total revenues generated along with detailed expenditures
- The number of students eligible for a waiver, number of students receiving a waiver, and the value of the waivers
- Changes in retention rates
- Graduation rates
- Percentage of students graduating with more than 110 percent of hours required for graduation
- Pass rates on licensure examinations
- Number of undergraduate course offerings
- Percentage of undergraduate students who are taught by faculty
- Student-faculty ratios
- Average salaries of faculty teaching undergraduate courses
- Differential Tuition
 - BOG staff proposed the creation of an additional field on the Student Information File (formerly Student Data Course File) in which universities would report, starting in fall 2009, the total dollars charged for tuition differential on a course-by-course, student-by-student basis.
 - A few universities expressed reservations that (a) this level of detail is greater than the minimum required by statute and (b) the time frame for making this change is too short, particularly in light of ongoing work to implement the State University Data System (SUDS).

 - In an effort to balance information needs with implementation challenges, for the 2009-10 academic year the BOG office will collect aggregated data sufficient to meet the requirements of statute. These data will include the number of students charged the tuition differential, number of undergraduate students exempt from payment (those enrolled prior to July 2007, those with prepaid contracts purchased prior to July 2007), number of students paying the tuition differential who are eligible for FSAG, number of students eligible for FSAG for whom the university waived the tuition differential, dollars per credit hour charged and any variation in that charge among courses or instructional sites, and total revenue generated.
 - Additional course-level detail along the lines BOG staff proposed in the May 11 conference call will be collected starting in the 2010-11 academic year.
- Veteran Indicator and a flag for the benefit they are eligible for, if any.
 - Are you a veteran of the US armed forces? Y/N
 - Which of the following are you eligible for:
 - The Post-9/11 GI Bill

 - SIF/SIFP/ADM: If fee_class_res = T and race_ethnicity = O then Visa_Typ must not be undocumented.
 - Not applicable?
- Allow no students enrolled for credit for medical courses
 - SIF: Diagnostic 0495: Change error message to indicate that there are no students enrolled for credit in courses_taken for the IAF course with var_cred_flg <> 'M'
- Can the SIFD go against as yet unaccepted SIF records for editing purposes?

- Grad I/Grad II for students still in the pipe-line after the termination/phase date.
 - If a student is a doctoral level student and the university eliminates the doctoral program, the student's grad hours will be classed as grad II . If the submission is beyond the phased date, the use of the CIP for the doctoral will have to be explained and accepted.
 - If a student is in a specialist program and the corresponding doctoral program is deleted, the specialist hours will be grad I.
- Highest Degree Level Held (01112) and Institution awarding (01114) is Florida Community College (CC). Add 'O - Other' to the allowed codes.

• COURSES

- Courses meeting times between midnight and 6am will be level 9 errors.

• DEGREE

- Add primary key for enrollment to table
- Require an enrollment record for the term.

• IAF

- Courses error out when in COURSES_TAKEN table and not in INSTRUCTIONAL_ACTIVITY table and the only message is "Bad Data Contents". Could the message be more instructive?
- Diagnostic 0007 (missing) for system generated Crs_Sectn_Typ_Pri triggers when the value cannot be assigned from the Courses_Taken table (crs_sectn_typ_pri must have one and only one value on all Courses_Taken records). The error message shown is 'Missing'. We will make the message more descriptive.

• WAIVERS

- Need to eliminate the UBOT fee waiver kind from the WAIVERS
 - Beginning with the Summer 2009 file submissions, we are proposing a change to the coding of University Board of Trustees' (UBOT) waivers. The code for UBOT waivers will be removed from the element Fee Waiver Kind/3rd Party Kind (01108). The universities are requested to code the waiver as to type, from the available codes. The authorization for the waiver is reported in element Waiver Indicator/3rd Party Indicator (01463). By placing assorted waiver in the UBOT code, it is not possible to identify the general type of waiver. If the available codes do not cover a type of waiver that your university is using, please let us know.
- Need definition of waiver types.
 - Type I Out-of-State Tuition Waiver - Out-of-State portion of tuition and fees waived
 - Type II Non-State Fundable - all of the courses waived in this manner are not counted for funding purposes. (Senior Citizen, courses which are funded from non-university sources, or exchange programs where the fees are paid at the originating institution.
 - Type III State Fundable - waivers that are given that do not change the fundability of the course.
 - Type IV Linkage Tuition Exemption - FS 288.8175 Each institute is allowed to exempt from s. [1009.21](#) up to 25 full-time equivalent students per year from the respective host countries to study in any of the state universities or community colleges in this state as resident students for tuition purposes. The institute directors shall develop criteria, to be approved by the Department of Education, for the selection of these students.
- Waivers paid out of C&G - If the fee is paid for out of the grant, then is it third party pay and should have C&G as the funding source. If a university counts a fee waiver as matching funds for a grant, it would be an E&G waiver.
- Waivers paid out of auxiliary are also allowed.

• SALARY CATEGORY DETAIL/EMPLOYEE

- The edit on Race/Ethnicity will now allow ' . - Not reported' for employees with a tolerance of 1%.
- Age of student or employee less than 14 will become a level 9 error (not level 5).
- HIGHEST_DEGREE_HELD. . . we currently accept 'Z' (not reported). We will require it on salaried faculty. We would expect missing only on non-salaried pay plans (OPS, non-SUS Compensated) .

- A request has been made to do the following: For the January and July SCD can SUDS implement a switch to filter for E&G only? This would keep us from having to change our internal software. How many universities want to do this?

 - Insert only E&G employee_data rows

Some schools routinely have a large number of differences in the CIP reported on a course (SIF) assigned by content/subject where there is no academic department, but the workload reporting CIP is a real department benefiting or paying.

- For continuing TEF students why do we need to send DOE_PGM_INFO again?
 - We only want students when they admit or complete.
- Add edit for FTCE scores (FLAG?) for those seeking a 'B' or 'M'
- CLAST is no longer required.
- FELE Exam required for Education Leadership (285)
- Ed Leadership (285) will not be re-authorized above the masters level.
- Change definition of Alternate Location to match Campus Code

• HOURS TO DEGREE

- Term/Annual submissions?
- add demo and enrollment if adding a degree and there is not one for that term.
- HTDNOMATCH Report - add UNIV_ROW_ID from Degrees_Awarded table for those awards that met the criteria but were not included in the HTD submission. (we couldn't do this last year because the matching degrees were from legacy)
- Add a field for reporting excess charges for a course?

- Veteran question for 2010
 - Are you a veteran of the U.S. Military? N/Y/9=if yes, serve on or after 09/11/2001?
 - Are you eligible to receive VA educational benefits as the spouse or dependent child of a veteran?
- New Admissions scale
 A student applying for admission summer/fall 2009 or later must have a High School GPA in the required academic courses equaling any entry in the GPA column, with an **SAT Reasoning Test (critical reading, mathematics, and reading)**/ACT score equaling or exceeding the corresponding entry below:

- Add reporting of Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) scores
- Question: Final Admission Action cannot be 'X' for registered student when a valid exception_typ (F,T,M,G) does not exist. Why can we not use other types such as "R" for recommendations?
 - If a student is a profile exception then they are an exception 'F' and the basis for admissions would be 'R - Recommendations'.
- Questions: Could we reduce the required fields for denied and withdrawn FTIC applicants? - NO
 - If there is an admission action taken, then questions are raised about who gets admitted and who get denied and why.
 - For students who are not admitted the following are not required:
 - High school and College GPA
 - Discipline CIP
 - Profile Assessment Flag
 - Student Classification Level
 - Language, Admission Scale, and High School Units Requirement
 - Institution Granting Highest Degree and Degree Held
 - All Admissions Tests
