**Continuing Services Contract Selection**

Presentations will be held in Room 114 of Mendenhall Maintenance Building "A" at the Florida State University on May 23<sup>rd</sup> and Room 101 on June 10<sup>th</sup>. Due to the tightness of the meeting room we ask that you bring no more than a total of 3 staff members for your presentation. The interview will consist of a fifteen-minute presentation followed by a fifteen-minute question and answer period.

Each firm's presentation should address the following criteria as it relates to their proposals:

- 1. <u>Understanding of the Program and Project Requirements:</u> The applicants will be evaluated on the understanding of the requirements and needs of the program and various types of project as demonstrated by their project team, including consultants. The Applicants shall be rated on the completeness of their understanding of the factors that are unique to University projects, including the thoroughness demonstrated in analyzing and investigating the scope of the project and in preparing for the interview.
- 2. <u>Approach and Method:</u> The Selection Committee will consider the Applicants' and their consultants' approach to the needs of the various University projects and methods

proposed for planning, designing, and administration of the projects. The Applicants will be asked to identify by name the key personnel for their proposed team: project manager, project engineer, and other key staff members. The applicant shall also identify those responsible in areas such as: mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, structural engineering, etc. Compensation for consultants listed on the Professional Qualifications Supplement will be deemed to be included within the basic fee.

- 3. <u>Ability to Provide Service:</u> The Selection Committee will evaluate the Applicant's ability to meet the Owner's required timetable and to provide for the special or unique requirements of University projects, including a projected time-line of activities through completion of the construction. The Applicants will discuss their ability to fulfill each University type project requirement, including proposed schedule and budget. The Applicants are to describe all other projects on which team members are currently involved. Results of the reference checks will be considered in this category.
- 4. **Proposed Team**: The applicant will be evaluated on their selection of key personnel which will be part of the engineering team for projects and their cities of residence. Please remember that key personnel must be committed to this project for its duration unless excused by the Owner.

Additionally, you are requested to bring your presentation on a thumb drive, as well as provide and leave five (5) hard copies and one (1) electronic copy of a summary of your presentation.
